6.3 Competitor Briefing

The compulsory competitor briefing will be conducted at 1700, Friday 19 September in the Safari HQ at Wanneroo Showgrounds.

The optional "First Timers" briefing will be conducted at the same location from 1600 to 1700. Competitors are excused from Safari Show commitments to attend the above briefings.

6.5 Post Event Scrutineering

Post event scrutineering will be conducted at the Parc Ferme located adjacent to the Ceremonial Finish on the Kalbarri foreshore. Competitors may be requested to move their vehicles to another location close by in order to conduct more detailed vehicle checks.

7.1 Roadbooks

Roadbooks (and scrolls) for Leg 0 will be issued at the conclusion of the Competitor Briefing at the same location.

7.2 Odometer Check

There will be two odometer checks for the event. One will be located near the Wanneroo Showgrounds and the other will be within Leg 0. A map is attached.

7.4 Safari Show and Ceremonial Start

A Safari Show and Ceremonial Start will be held at the Wanneroo Showgrounds on Friday 19th September 2014.

All vehicles will be required to park in the allocated area and be on display from 1600 hrs until the Ceremonial Start at 1900 hrs. All competitors will be required to travel at walking pace through the archway. Helmets are not required.

Report times at the Ceremonial Start, in reverse seeded order, will be published at documentation.

Competitors are requested to be ready to start 15 minutes before their Ceremonial Start time. The first competitor will leave the Ceremonial Start at 1900.

Murchison Communications Blackout

Our approval for our technology and communication systems comes with the condition that all communication devices including radios, sat phones, wifi, RallySafe units and mobile phones must be deactivated by Sunset (1820) at the end of Leg 1.

These devices can all be activated at Sunrise (0605) at the commencement of Leg 2.

Vehicle Groups and Classes

Add in the following:

1.6 Hybrid or dual powered vehicles, all capacities.

These vehicles must be commercially available for sale within Australia and be powered by a combustion engine, in addition to another source of propulsion such as electrical.

FIA Group T3.3

Maximum Engine Capacity is now 2000 cc.

Suspension is free.

Provisional and Final Results

Provisional results will be posted on the Official Noticeboard at 1830 and subject to the resolution of any protests, will become final at 1900.

Course Changes

Due to some very recent fencing activity and road works, if the course cars have to direct competitors around the roadbook route, arrows and bunting will be used. A hand written sign will indicate the correct distance at the first instruction on the roadbook after the route is re-joined.

Red Caution Signs

The course cars may place a red caution board along the course. This will indicate a new caution on the route that was not in existence when the road book was written.

Working on Vehicles / Refuelling Vehicles

Service Crews and Competitors are forbidden from working on any competition vehicle whilst it is being refuelled.

Refuel and Distance Matrix

The refuel and distance matrix is attached.

Due to some recent changes to the course and rejection of previously approved competition areas we have had to modify both Legs 5 and 7.

The TC 0 for Legs 5 and 7 is located some considerable distance from the overnight bivouac location. The distance from the overnight bivouac to the Start does NOT form part of the liaison/transport distance and as such competitors may transport their vehicles by any means. Competitors are reminded to report at the "Start" as per their start time and that the standard penalties will apply.
